#### Percentage Scores

For the first time taking the tests, results close to 40% is a very common starting point and lots of children go on to pass having started at this level. Results above 50% are good for this stage of the year. Based on the difficulty of the Clare's Learning Club tests, by the end of the summer term, for a confident pass of the Eleven Plus, scores should be close to or above 65%, with no score lower than 58% on any individual paper.

#### S Standardised scores

This is similar as to how it will be calculated in the Kent Test and other Year 11 tests.

At this stage is a loose indicator, I have standardised it based on the group results and where we are in the year. A projected clear pass at this stage would be a score of 290 or more, with no single score in a test lower than 80 (40 in the individual reasoning papers). The highest score on the English paper, maths paper and combined reasoning is 141, the highest possible total score is 423. If the scores are lower than the pass band, at this stage, it does not mean they are not capable of passing.

S\* This score is the standardised score taking into account the child's age at the test date.

Last year, to be given a grammar school place, children needed a total score of 323 or more, with no single score lower than 107 in each of the three papers.

## Types of Comprehension Questions

### LITERAL

You can find the answer directly in the text. To answer them well you need to read the text very carefully and find the exact words that tell you what the questions asks.

### DEDUCTIVE

The text **does not actually tell** you, but you can **work out** the answer directly from information the text gives you. To answer them well you need to read the text very carefully and **work things out from the information you are given** (but **not make things up** of your own).

### INFERENCE

The text **does not actually tell** you, but you can **work out** the answer by considering the **hints and clues** in the text from your own knowledge and experience. To answer well you need to read the text very carefully and **draw conclusions of your own from the hints and clues you are given** (but **not completely make things up**, or jump to conclusions not supported by the text).

### Additional Comments

On target for the first time taking the test. I'm particularly impressed with your score for the **missing words**. Do make sure you are reading the text twice, make some notes, underline or star key information as you go and always read a few lines before and after when you refer back to the text for a specific question. Also, try eliminating at least two answers before you commit to an answer. Definitely correct any wrong answers to see where you made the mistakes.

### Additional Comments

Your highest score! Speed, accuracy and a wide vocabulary are key skills on this paper. From the results, I'm wondering if you weren't sure how to do quite a few of the sections or may have misread what you needed to do, this isn't a problem as there's plenty of time to build your confidence and identify which of the sections you are best at. If you find spelling an issue then it would be best to focus on the codes and maths sections, although they can be time consuming, you can get a definite answer. We will be covering all the codes topics again over the next few weeks.

### TIPS AND ADVICE

#### General

The key is to be disciplined, systematic and look for the rules, study each element in a sequence, rule out and eliminate options as you go. Improving your understanding of shading, symmetry, rotation, direction and shape will help. An excellent way to practise is to write down the rule or rules for each question. If your scores are on the low side, start doing this by using the answer to identify and then write down the rule/s for each question.

#### 1: Analogies

Find the rule or rules that have been applied to the first to turn it into the next shape and apply to the next shape.

#### 2: Matrices

Divide the box and work horizontally or vertically, look for the patterns or changes, similar to series.

#### 3: Series

Look for separate changes or operations and apply to each shape to see if it has happened e.g rotation, addition or subtraction of shapes or lines, mirroring.

#### 4: Blocks

Match up the shapes in the main shape to the individual blocks. Be aware of how shapes change looking from different angles.

#### 5: Folding

A difficult section. It's essential to look at the answer options and eliminate the ones it can't be. A good understanding of line and angles will help. Draw shapes and fold them to see how the lines lay over each other.

#### 6: Nets

Sides separated by 1 square can't touch. Look to eliminate answers where they do touch. There will be another session where we cut out nets and put them together in different ways.
